Working Group Dermatopathology

The Dermatopathology Working Group was founded in 2007 by Professors Glatz and Mihic-Probst as a joint platform for pathologists as well as clinical dermatologists practicing dermatohistopathology.

Goals:

Exchange of interesting and challenging predominantly dermal neoplasms as well as inflammatory skin conditions, if necessary, development of guidelines and information concerning international working groups (International Melanoma Group, EORTC Melanoma Group).

Procedure:

2-3 times annually, 2.5-hour meetings, mostly in Zurich, focusing on a specific theme with possibly a brief presentation, bringing along theme-related cases but other cases are also welcome.

Target audience:

Representatives from all major university/non-university, public/private pathologies as well as clinically active dermatopathologists.

However, younger participants at any stage of their training are also very welcome.
